We also had some young helpers that showed up to help with setting up pins. It was a great time for all.

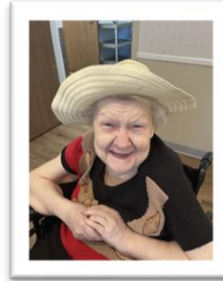
